As long as the video policy is clearly and prominently posted outside (and inside) the meeting rooms, audience members will have sufficient notice about video recording.

"This session is being video-recorded. By attending this session, you acknowledge that your image and comments may be recorded and re-broadcast."

We suggest including a notice in registration materials as well as in collateral materials:

"Some sessions of SCxx may be video-recorded, and video recordings may be made in general sessions and common areas as well. By registering to attend SCxx, you are granting SC permission to record your image, comments, and questions during sessions."

VIDEO CONSENT AND RELEASE FORM

1.
